At the same time, Charles serves as Director of Music of the Dodd-Sterling United Methodist Church over 9 years where he serves on the ministerial team. Charles has developed the music program from a 6 member choir to two choirs, a praise team, and three dance teams. Also, as a part of the program, a Fine Arts component has been successfully teaching students to master performing the arts through drums, voice, and piano for over 7 years. Charles has served as the Chaplain to the graduate Pi Gamma Lambda Chapter, of the Alpha Phi Alpha Fraternity, Inc at Ft. McPherson, GA where he is currently the Vice President. He is also serving as the Project Alpha Chair for the Georgia District of Alpha Phi Alpha, a national program with the March of Dimes and Alpha Phi Alpha to mentor African American Teens on responsibility, respect, relationship, and sexually transmitted diseases.
